15 th & 16 th	11am	A Walk in the Past- Berkhamsted Place Meet at top of Castle Hill/ Murray Road	Visitors will experience something of the grandeur of what remains of the original 'Royal' Mansion. Tours will include a visit to the Great Barn - older than the mansion. There will be a small display explaining the history of the house and of Reg Butler's work - a sculptor who once lived here.
16 th	10.30am & 2pm	Berkhamsted's Finest Architect Charles Henry Rew Meet at All Saints Church. 	This tour celebrates the remarkable but largely forgotten legacy of Charles Henry Rew who designed a lot of Edwardian /Victorian Berkhamsted buildings.
17 th	10.30am & 2pm	Old Hall and Chapel Berkhamsted School Meet at Berkhamsted School Castle Street entrance	Visitors will have the opportunity of seeing the original school-house built in 1544 (Grade I listed), to learn something about the history of the school (founded in 1541) and see the beautiful little Victorian chapel.
